
EXPORTING IN WEVIDEO

TUTORIAL TRANSCRIPT

Once you've finished constructing your digital story, you have all of the elements on your timeline, you have finished all of your finite editing, applied transitions, finished your captioning, it's now time to export.

So, we're going to go to the top right-hand corner of our screen, and click "finish."

It's asking me to set a title for my export. I'm going to title my film, "Sugar Hill."

And now it takes me to the export window. If I did not want to export my film I could go to the top left-hand corner of the screen and click back to "editor" and this will take me back to my timeline. But, because I am ready to export my film I'm going to ensure that I have "export video" selected, I'm going to change the resolution from "SD" to "HD", this ensures that I am getting the highest quality video possible. And then WeVideo allows you to directly export your film to a number of different platforms including YouTube and Vimeo but for the purposes



of our workshop, we export directly to WeVideo so that we can download our film from our WeVideo account.

So, once I have ensured that everything is set to the way that I like I click "export" and WeVideo tells me that my video will soon finish exporting I don't need to keep this window open, they'll send me an e-mail when my video is ready. You can then access your video through the "export" or "exports" tab in your WeVideo account.
